## Siskin Children's Institute Center for Developmental Pediatrics

In the past, Siskin Children's Institute Center for Developmental Pediatrics (CDP) has been offering psychoeducational assessment services exclusively through referrals from medical providers within the center. After assessing the needs of our community, we are pleased to announce that the institute will now be offering specific psychoeducational services to families and children referred directly from local physicians. Along with supporting diagnostic impressions, we believe these assessment services will provide each family the opportunity to understand the potential learning strengths and weaknesses of their child and work to help them develop a plan for appropriate intervention.

*Please Note: Referrals for Autism Spectrum Disorders, Behavioral Difficulties, Anxiety, Cerebral Palsy, etc., should continue to be referred to the CDP medical staff.*

Assessment services for the following concerns can be directly initiated by a referral from a pediatrician: Specific Learning Disorders, ADHD, and Intellectual Disability

Testing typically includes: Two separate testing sessions, a detailed report with intervention strategies, and a consultation appointment with the family to review the assessment results

Potential assessments include: Cognitive assessments (IQ), academic assessments (achievement), visual-motor integration assessments, along with other rating scales (ADHD, etc.)

Available for children ages 5-18

These assessments are offered on a fee-for-services basis, yet our fees have been significantly reduced to help minimize the expense to families
